Rewarding Regulations for Outstanding Courses in Undergraduate and All
Other Programs Delivered in English

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Modified and approved at the 3th administrative meeting during the 1st semester of the 2017 academic year, October 11, 2017

Article 1 Regulations for rewarding outstanding teaching basing on the result of teaching surveys at National Sun Yat-sen University

Article 2 The Regulations are implemented once a year for the courses given in the last semester.

Article 3 The rewarding specified in the Regulations is applicable to the obligatory and elective courses **in all programs** that meet the following requirements:

1. **Undergraduate program:** The retrieval rate of the Teaching Survey questionnaires (seven-point scale) reaches

70% **of the student number** and fulfill one of the following requirement:

(1) Courses with 30 students which obtain a satisfaction score above 6.1 points.

(2) Courses with 50 students which obtain a satisfaction score above 6.0 points.

(3) Courses with 75 students which obtain a satisfaction score above 5.9 points.

(4) Courses with 95 students which obtain a satisfaction score above 5.8 points.

(5) Courses with 115 students which obtain a satisfaction score above 5.7 points

(6) Courses **in all programs** that are delivered in English (excluding courses given by a foreign teacher and the professional English course of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures) and more than 20 students take the course with a satisfaction score of more than 5.7 points.

2. **Courses other than Bachelor program courses:**
the retrieval rate has to reach 70% of the student number and one of the following requirements as for the teaching survey (seven-degree scale) has to be met:

(1)the number of students attending the course is higher then 12 and the average satisfaction score is of 6.4 or higher;

(2)the number of students attending the course is higher then 25 and the average satisfaction score is of 6.3 or higher;

(3)the number of students attending the course is higher then 40 and the average satisfaction score is of 6.2 or higher.

3. Any type of course: except for full-time teachers who came to the university in the past three years, those teachers who in the past two years have gathered 25 or more copies of the "Survey on the Satisfaction of the Graduates with the Department/Institute and Teacher returned" and, in the past two years received an average students' satisfaction rate of 5.5 or higher (seven-degrees scale). However,

those new teachers who have been teaching full-time at newly-established faculties, shall start collecting statistical data starting from the semester when the first batch of future graduates is about to leave the university by handing out the "Survey on the Satisfaction of the Graduates with the Department/Institute and Teacher returned".

Article 4 The president will award the teacher of the course that meets the requirements of Article 3 a **certificate of merit**.

Article 5 The Regulations are approved at the administrative meeting of the university and implemented after approved by the president. The same procedure is applicable to the amendment of the Regulations.
