Article 1. Objectives:

The Guidelines were established to encourage diligence in learning and the habit of reading among students.

Article 2. Applicability and criteria:

All students at the university (excluding students with extended study periods) in the semester the award is granted may qualify for the award if they satisfied the following criteria in the preceding semester:

- 1. The student's academic performance was ranked in the top 5% (the quota is rounded up to the nearest integer) of each class and there were no failed courses.
 - Departments may set their own selection criteria but this must be approved by the department affairs meeting and Academic Affairs Council prior to implementation.
- 2. The student selected up to 15 credits from the first to third year, and selected 9 credits in the fourth year.
- 3. The student received a grade of A- (80 in the percentage system) or higher for conduct with no demerits or absentee classes.

Article 3. Review procedure:

The Office of Academic Affairs shall forward the list of student rankings for the semester to each department once the grades have been finalized. Candidates are then selected based on each department's award criteria, conditions and quota then submitted to the University President for approval.

Article 4. Reward:

The Office of Academic Affairs shall forward the list of recipients approved by the University President to the Office of Student Affairs for the English and Chinese award certificate and cash prize of NT\$6000 issuing assignments.

Article 5. Other:

- 1. Winners of this award are still eligible to apply for other prizes or scholarships.
- 2. The Guidelines were approved by the Academic Affairs Council and sanctioned by the University President prior to implementation. Modifications shall follow the same procedure.

第一條 目的:

為鼓勵學生努力向學、提高讀書風氣,特設置本辦法。

第二條 獎勵對象及標準:

凡頒獎學期在校生(不含延長修業之學生)其前學期表現合於下列 各項標準者:

一、學業成績在各班級中名列前百分之五(名額採小數點進位) 且無不及格科目。

各學系得另訂篩選標準,惟須經系務會議及教務會議審議通過 後公佈實施。

- 二、學生所選科目學分數,一至三年級達十五學分,四年級達九學 分。
- 三、操行成績 A-等第(百分制八十分)以上,且未受處分及無曠課紀錄。

第三條 審查程序:

由教務處於成績定案後,將學生學期排名送交各學系依其受獎標準、限制及名額圈選,陳請校長核定。

第四條 獎勵方式:

由教務處將校長核定名單送請學生事務處辦理中英文獎狀及獎金陸仟元等發放作業。

第五條 附則:

- 一、獲得本獎之學生亦可申請其他獎或獎學金。
- 二、本辦法經教務會議通過,陳請校長核定後實施,修正時亦同。
